I. UKF CHAMPIONS LEAGUE GENERAL SCHEDULE

1.1 UKF Champions League is divided into four (4) phases:

- Qualifying round(s)
- Group stage (3 rounds)
- Semi-finals
- Final

1.2 UKF qualifying round(s) is (are) run in a play-off system, with one (1) match between each teams.

1.2.1 The draw result of Qualifying round(s) is presented on the UKF website.

1.2.2 In case of having 8 or less teams registered, the UKF Champions League start straight from the Group stage, without the Qualifying round(s).

1.3 Group stage consists of 8 teams allocated in 2 groups (4 teams per group) - teams will be the winners of the qualifying round(s).

1.3.1 The composition of groups is made in a on-line live broadcast draw.

1.3.2 Group stage is run in the round robin system, with one (1) match between each teams.

1.3.3 Points are allocated as per following table:

Win	Tie	Loss
3	1	0

1.3.4 Group stage classification is updated and published on the UKF website after every round.

1.3.5 After completing final classification of the Group stage, the first and second team (winner and runner-up) from each group goes to Semi-final.

1.4 Semi-finals are composed as follow: Winner of Group A vs. Runner-Up of Group B; Winner of Group B vs. Runner-Up of Group A.

1.4.1 Semi-finals are run in a play-off system, with one (1) match between each teams.

1.4.2 Winners of Semi-finals goes to the Final.

1.5 Final is broadcasted live on-line.

1.5.1 The winner of UKF Champions League receive the UKF World Cup.

II. COMMITMENT TO RULES

2.1 All UKF Champions League matches are subject to the jurisdiction of UKF and shall comply with, be bound by and conduct the match in accordance with UKF rules and regulations.

2.2 The online UKF Official Rulebook is the official version of the UKF Champions League Karate rules.

III. UKF CHAMPIONS LEAGUE CATEGORIES

3.1 UKF Champions League is organized in following categories:

- Kata Team Male
- Kata Team Female
- Kumite Team Grand Rotation Male
- Kumite Team Grand Rotation Female

IV. UKF CHAMPIONS LEAGUE PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

4.1 Only teams who will pay the annual license can participate in each UKF Champions League season.

4.2 Teams have to be minimum National Champions (any federation).

4.3 UKF Champions League teams can be comprised only by adult competitors (minimum 18 years old), with valid UKF annual license.

V. UKF CHAMPIONS LEAGUE PRIZE MONEY

5.1 The winner (team who will got 1st place) in every category receive a prize money € 1 000.

VI. REGISTRATION

6.1 Registration is made on line via the UKF website.

VII. TRANSFERS OF THE ATHLETES

7.1 After registration for each UKF Champions League season is done, teams can change their composition adding/replacing athletes. Such procedure is call a transfer.

7.2 During the season there are two transfer windows, when the transfers can be done:

- At the start of the season, before first Qualification round
- After completing all rounds of the Group stage, but before starting Semi-finals

7.3 Each athlete transfer must be paid to UKF. Transfer fee per athlete is € 200.
